

Guatemala, Genuine Antigua El Tecolote



El Tecolote Estate, is located in San Juan del Obispo, Antigua Guatemala, Sacatepéquez, at 1,600. This little farm is right at the slopes of the Agua Volcano. The plantation started 4 years ago in an area that has been planted with coffee from the 16th century, when Don Juan de Carmona came to Guatemala with the Spanish conqueror Don Pedro de Alvarado and start cultivating a variety of agricultural products this are, lately in the 1800's these lands were planted with coffee. Right at the beginning of the coffee production of Guatemala.

Genuine Antigua “El Tecolote” got its name from the owl famous on the Mayan culture and this bird is also a symbol of Antigua Guatemala. Usually, represented by a clay empty figure that is used for saving coins.

The whole area was original planted with Nispero, a local fruit tree which shades the coffee trees.
